**Subject: 2002 Natural Gas Pipeline System Anti Drug and Alcohol Misuse Inspection**

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) has the authority to enforce minimum safety regulations per Chapter 480-93 of the Washington Administrative Code pertaining to the construction, maintenance, and operation of pipelines transporting natural gas in the state of Washington. In addition, the Commission adopts the Code of Federal Regulation (CFR) Title 49 Part 199 and Department of Transportation (DOT) Procedures in Part 40 as the minimum standards for anti-drug and alcohol misuse prevention programs.

On November 5-8, 2002, Commission staff conducted an on-site standard inspection of the City of Enumclaw Natural Gas Department's anti-drug and alcohol misuse plan and programs. The inspection included a review of records and plans pertaining to the anti-drug and alcohol misuse programs for the City of Enumclaw Natural Gas Department.

No violations of state or federal codes were noted as a result of the inspection of Enumclaw's anti-drug and alcohol misuse programs. It should not be assumed that this inspection detected all apparent non-compliances of regulations at this time. It is incumbent upon the operator to review its operation to determine whether or not there are other areas of non-compliance.
